REFRACTION FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

The refraction is a specific eye examination that determines a person's exact prescription for eyeglasses.

Please be advised that medical insurances will generally NOT cover the refraction since it is considered a vision service, and Zelenak Eye Institute is not contracted with Vision Insurance (which is non-Medical insurance that covers routine glasses and contact lens examinations).

The fee for a refraction is \$40.00 at our office.

You have the right to decline a refraction and if you have vision insurance, use your vision insurance with a contracted provider to obtain this service. You have the right to request an itemized receipt to submit to your vision insurance requesting reimbursement; however, you must understand there is no guarantee that your vision plan will reimburse you, and it is your responsibility to file this with your plan. We will not file this for you.

We will not file this charge with your medical insurance since it is not considered a covered service. You may ask us to bill it to your insurance, but the fee will still be due at the time of service. In the rare event that medical insurance reimburses the refraction, you will be reimbursed the fee and notified.

I understand that the refraction is NOT typically a covered service by medical insurance and that I will incur an out-of-pocket expense of \$40.00 if performed, to be collected at the time of service.
